ILYKEITM PRIVACY POLICY

iLykei Teaching Tech. Corp. ("iLykei" or "We") is committed to safeguarding your personal privacy. This Privacy Policy describes how We collect, use and handle your information when you use our website ("Site"), or interact with us. It also explains how you may control certain uses of your personal information. This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and made part of our Terms of Use. The terms used in the Terms of Use have the same meaning herein.

Our Privacy Policy explains our information practices including the following:

1. **Personal Information Collected.** When you use our website (the "Services"), we collect two types of information: personal information and usage data. The personal information We collect includes your e-mail address and how frequently you access our Site. We do not collect, use or transmit any biometric identifiers as defined in the Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act.

Information We Collect Through Automated Means. When you access the Site, We collect certain information by automated means. This information may include the following: (a) technical information about your computer or device you use to access the Site, such as your e-mail address, device type, browser and other technical information (collectively "Technical Information"); and (b) the frequency of your usage or interaction with our Site including content accessed, time you spent on the Site, search inquiries and other information relating to your use of the Site (collectively "Usage Data"). Generally, We do not consider Usage Data as personal information, because Usage Data by itself does not identify an individual. Our website does not use cookies.

In this way, We may automatically collect information such as your browser type, operating system, computer type and carrier, internet service provider, and e-mail address.

2. <u>How We Use Your Information</u>. We may use information about you to contact you from time to time, including for any of the following purposes: (a) to provide educational services; (b) to allow users to review course materials; (c) to improve our Site; and (d) as otherwise described herein.

3. <u>When And With Whom We Share Your Information</u>. We do not sell or otherwise share your personal information about our Site users, except as described herein. We do not share personal information with unaffiliated third parties.

We may share information We collect from and about you in the following ways: (i) with third party service providers We have hired to maintain the Site; (ii) as necessary to investigate or prevent any actual or suspected improper activity or injury to iLykei or others, as permitted by law; (iii) if We believe that there has been a violation of our Terms of Use or of our rights or the rights of any third party; and (iv) to respond to legal process, complaints, subpoenas, court orders, or to provide information to law enforcement authorities and regulatory agencies, or as otherwise required by law.

Links To Other Websites. The Site may contain links to other websites. We provide these links solely for your convenience and information. Those other sites have different privacy policies. Please check the privacy policy of the specific site you are visiting to understand the privacy practice of that site. We are not responsible for the content or the privacy practices of third party sites.

4. **How Long Do We Retain Your Information.** For Student Users, we delete intermediate scores within thirty (30) days after the following: (i) withdrawal from the course; or (ii) course completion. When a Student User's University e-mail address is no longer in effect, the Student User will not have access to the Site through such University e-mail address.

For other Users, We generally retain your information for a reasonable period of time to use the information as specified in this Privacy Policy. We can keep information about you and your interactions with the Site for a period of time that is consistent with applicable law or as We believe is reasonably necessary to comply with applicable law. In certain circumstances, We may anonymize your personal data (so it is no longer associated with you) for analytical purposes, in which case We may use this information indefinitely without further notice to you. This allows specific information to become anonymous, but it allows us to keep the statistical data. This retention of data will allow us to maintain a level of information that helps develop and improve our Services.

5. <u>Children's Personal Data</u>. We do not knowing solicit or collect personal data from children below the age 16. If We discover that We have accidently collected personal data from a child below 16, We will remove the child's personal data from our records as soon as reasonably possible. We may collect personal data about children below the age of 16 years of age from a parent or a guardian directly with their consent.

6. <u>Rights And Choices</u>. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, do not access or use our Site or interact with our Site.

Please note that We store information as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, and may continue retaining use information even after a request for purposes of our legitimate interest, including to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and prevent fraud or injury. We may need to retain certain information for record keeping purposes or to comply with our legal obligations.

<u>Your Rights Under The European Union's General Data Protection Regulation</u>. Where European Union's General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR") applies to the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights, subject to some limitations:

- The right to access your personal data;
- The right to rectify the personal data We hold about you;
- The right to erase your personal data;
- The right to restrict our use of your personal data;
- The right to object to our use of your personal data;
- The right to receive your personal data in a usable electronic format and transmit it to a third party (also known as the right of data portability); and
- The right to lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority.

If you would like to exercise any of these rights, you may do so by contacting us in accordance with Section 8.

Where the GDPR applies, you also have the right to withdraw any consent you have given to uses of your personal data. If you wish to withdraw consent that you have previously provided to us, you may request us to do so.

7. **Changes To Privacy Policy.** We may amend this Privacy Policy from time to time by posting a revised version and updating the "Effective Date" specified on the Privacy Policy. The revised version will be effective on the "Effective Date" specified. You may stop using the Site at any time, but your continued use of the Site after the "Effective Date" of any modifications to the Privacy Policy means you agree to any amendment of this Privacy Policy.
